I'm guessing that the stock manifolds are the most restrictive part of the exhaust and you aren't going to see much difference by changing things downstream. I remember someone doing a comparison on a 944 Cup car with headers and finding very little difference by changing from stock exhaust to aftermarket muffler to open pipe. IIRC, they were all within a couple of HP. Typically the more open the system, you gain a couple of HP at the expense of a couple of TQ for no
